



e-Learning Courses for TDSB Students in 2020-2021

If you are interested in taking a Grade 11 or 12 online course as part of your day school timetable this year, the e-Learning Day School program may be for you. You may take one e-Learning course in a quadmester as part of your day school timetable, to a maximum of two courses in the school year.

We invite you to consider becoming part of an online community that features continuous learning, positive communication and ongoing collaboration. e-Learning courses have been developed by the Ministry of Education and are delivered by regular TDSB day school teachers. They teach the content of the course, provide tutorial help and work with students one-on-one if requested.

Setting you up for success

Before you being an e-Learning course, you will be given access to an Introductory Module that shows you how to navigate Brightspace, the online learning program used for all our courses. Following the Introductory Module, you will attend an [online orientation](#) session with other students in your class to meet your e-Learning teacher and find out about the make up of the course—what will be taught, how your achievement will be evaluated, and what is expected of you.
